Plants

Bet reported on two requests:

Homeowner at 46 Starview Dr requested that the phorium (New Zealand flax) be replaced with a rhododendron.

Homeowners at 61 Starview Dr requested that the wisteria vine by their front door be removed and replaced with a hardenbergia (happy wanderer vine).

Work orders for these request will be submitted to Serpico.

The wrong size rocks were installed in front of 6676 Charring Cross. Bet will have the crew move them to the correct location.

The last work is being completed on the 2018 work order.

Trees

Two requests were received for tree work:

Homeowner at 34 Starview Dr requested that the trees by the front door be trimmed.

Homeowner at 46 Starview Dr requested that all of the trees between 46 SVD & 48 SVD be trimmed.

Akiko reported on the hour & half walk with Pam & Michael Saba & Martin regarding the goats.

The oleanders planted on the hillsides are poisonous to the goats, so Martin is proposing that the goats clean the hillside below the v-ditch and the hillside behind the downhill houses be hand cleared with a weed whacker. He will prepare a new bid to be submitted to the Board.

As a start date becomes more certain a notice will be passed out to residents.

Serpico will be contacted regarding the location of hose bibs, so water sources can be identified for the goats.
