TREES:

1. The decision has been made on which kind of tree will be used for replacement of the Callery Pears that have been removed. Discussion continued on how to prioritize the next round of which ones to plant first/where.
2. Discussion of status of existing homeowner requests and how to proceed.
3. Waiting until September 30th which is the cut off date for requests before proceeding with work already requested.
4. All diseased/dying Callery Pears have now been removed.

PLANTS:

IRRIGATION:

1. Have had Serpico re-calibrate our irrigation system to comply with EBMUD's new directive on limiting watering due to drought.
2. Two broken valves replaced.
